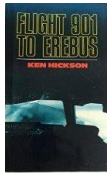


Books by Ken Hickson:



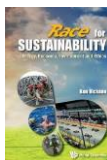
1. **"Flight 901 to Erebus"** (1980), Whitcoulls, New Zealand
Documentary account of a major international aviation disaster which occurred in the Antarctic involving an Air New Zealand DC10 on a sightseeing flight. All 257 on board perished.



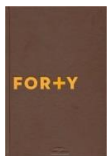
2. **"The Future South"** (1980), Bowden Communications, New Zealand.
